Dear Parent / Guardian

Skye Primary School is looking forward to next year bringing a great year of teaching and learning and would like to advise you of Skye Primary School's parent payment arrangements for 2021. In accordance with Department guidelines there are changes to the parent payment arrangements and every year level will be slightly different depending on the educational items required.

Attached is the fee schedule for **YEAR 6**. Please complete the attached form and return to the school by **13<sup>th</sup> November 2020** so the school can prepare accordingly. *Skye Primary School* makes every effort to keep the cost of items and activities to a minimum and affordable for all parents.

**All invoices for essential educational student learning items must be paid for no later than Friday 22nd January 2021. Stationery packs will be delivered directly to the student's 2021 classroom. This allows all students to commence the school year fully equipped on the first day of term one.**

### Financial Support for Families

*Skye Primary School* understands that some families may experience financial difficulty and offers a range of support options, including:

- the Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund (available for eligible holders of Health Care Cards, pension cards)
- Payment plans – ongoing weekly/fortnightly/monthly plans eg. \$10 per week.
- Access to State Schools Relief support for clothing / uniforms (via school)
- Second hand uniform – gold coin donation
